Dear Dr. Hull:

I have finally received the necessary information about Dr. T. J. Cole, one of our co-workers whose name appeared as a co-exhibitor.

We find that he will not have paid his dues in time to participate this year. We are, therefore, blotting out his name on the inclosed sheets of information for booth sign and descriptions of the exhibit so that you may be governed accordingly.

If I did not state in previous correspondence, we will need one of your transparency cases of the five foot X four foot eight description to rest on a six foot table, or ledge, against one of the side walls of our booth. This would mean the extention of the width of the back wall of the booth to a point equal to the width of the transparency case so that the available back wall space will still be twelve feet wide.
