Dear Doctor Berry:

Enclosed is a copy of the minutes of the meeting of the Advisory Committee on Narcotics which was held on Friday, January 5, 1952.

As Coordinator of our program in Chicago I would like to call your attention to certain items in the minutes which require action. It would be appreciated if you would determine the present status of these items and help in expediting their development.

1. Dr. Kelleher in his report stated that in approximately two or three weeks from the date of the Advisory Committee meeting he would be able to begin his screening program at the House of Correction. We would like to know whether this has begun.
2. It was suggested that the same committee that met with Warden Sain meet with the Warden at the County Jail. Although I was present at the meeting with Warden Sain it is not necessary that I be present at the other proposed meeting. I would appreciate it if you would proceed to arrange for such a meeting which would be attended by Miss Binford, Dr. Kelleher and yourself. If something has already been done in this regard, please let us know.
3. Dr. Cross appointed a committee consisting of the following: Dr. Scatliff, Dr. Sherman, Miss Binford and Dr. Adams to prepare a pamphlet for circulation at the showing of the new film on drug addiction to various P.T.A. groups. Will you please determine what activity if any, has occurred in this regard.

Several days ago each member of the Advisory Committee was forwarded the list of possible items of information that might be included on narcotics clinics report forms. To date we have had only four replies in this regard and since we are anxious to set up some type of record as soon as possible, we would appreciate it if you have not answered our previous letter, you would do so within the next day or so.
