Dear Doctor Casey:

In compliance with our telephone conversation yesterday, I am forwarding a copy of the program; a similar copy has gone to Mr. Smith, the understanding being that you will fill in the missing names for invocation, benediction, and a lady who would lead the song.

In case it may slip your memory, I should perhaps mention again that the national president of the Women's Auxiliary and perhaps the local president should be presented on the Tuesday evening program, and I suppose the new president would have a two-minute word of greeting on that program. All this is for preliminary announcements. Very shortly, I will send in the names of the honorees after a final re-confirmation that they will be present. I know already about Harkins and Mayo. I must get a final confirmation with reference to the young paraplegic intern in Columbus, although he has accepted. The same applies to the pharmacist from Mississippi.

The final programs to be handed out at these two meetings are printed locally as far as I know. At any rate, I will send my added information to both you and Sam Smith.

Also, I have not contacted Dr. Sabin with reference to his receiving the citation. I assume that you have done this since he was your nominee and he is there locally. I will, however, go ahead with sending an invitation as president, after you have confirmed the matter with him and advised me. I am sure that this is not too late if it is done within the next few days, since the doctor is going to appear on the program during the week.

This is all that I think of now. Many thanks for your co-operation and my very best wishes.
