

Chicago, as you know, has one of the world's largest medical centers and we have several top-level medical schools with excellent departments of gastroenterology. There is an active society of gastroenterology with representatives from these schools, as well as the Chicago Society of Internal Medicine, which offers excellent opportunities for growth. If you received an appointment in the Cook County Hospital Division of Gastroenterology, you would have an opportunity for a clinical appointment at the University of Illinois, probably as Assistant Clinical Professor. There are also opportunities for research and, as you know, our unit in gastrointestinal endoscopy is one of the largest and best organized in the country. Because of recent retirements, there would seem to be an excellent possibility for you here in Chicago.

If you feel that there is a possibility that you might be interested, please send a copy of your curriculum vitae at your earliest convenience. If you think you might be interested, a tour of Cook County Hospital at some point in time would probably be desirable.
