Dear Dan:

Thanks very much for the effort to make corrections. I have checked the program listings against the sketch of the booth positions and all of the booths seem to be 8 feet except two which are 12 feet and those are apparently in the center of the technical exhibits which, of course, would be undesirable should the reassignment be made in this area. It may be better to keep the booth at 8 feet rather than get an out of the way location.

The only description of dimensions of booths that I find in the outline gives me the impression that the side walls will rise only 3 feet from the floor while the back wall is 8 feet tall. We would need the side walls to come up to the height of the back wall, which is the usual construction for scientific booths. In summary, if the side walls can be raised to the height of the back wall we will go ahead and fit our exhibit to the 8 feet width.

I will send the abstract and copies under separate cover as soon as possible. I am sorry for this delay.
