Programs sponsored by the Colleges at Howard  
McHenry; I know that Dr. Butt is especially anxious  
to accomplish something in this area ~~during~~  
during his Administration.

I would like to further suggest that in  
order to ~~make~~ <sup>make</sup> this program <sup>more</sup> palatable  
to all concerned and more innovative, that a kind of  
"Clinical Grand Rounds" be set up at the  
Hubbard, and Freedman's Hospital <sup>by their faculty chiefs</sup>
