THE CHICAGO FAIR HOUSING ORDINANCE

WHAT DOES THE ORDINANCE DO?

IT PROHIBITS REAL ESTATE BROKERS FROM DISCRIMI-NATING BECAUSE OF RACE, COLOR, RELIGION, NATIONAL ORIGIN OR ANCESTRY IN THE SALE OR RENTAL OF RESI-DENTIAL REAL ESTATE IN THE CITY OF CHICAGO. IT ALSO PROVIDES THAT NO REAL ESTATE BROKER MAY SOLICIT RESIDENTIAL REAL ESTATE ON THE BASIS THAT ITS VALUE WILL BE LESSENED BECAUSE OF THE ENTRY INTO THE NEIGHBORHOOD OF PERSONS OF A PARTICULAR RACE, COLOR, RELIGION, NATIONAL ORIGIN OR ANGESTRY ("PANIC PEDDLING").

WHAT DO I DO IF I BELIEVE I HAVE BEEN DISCRIMINATED AGAINST?

WHAT DO I DO IF MY NEIGHBORHOOD IS BOTHERED BY A "PANIC PEDDLER"?

WHAT HAPPENS TO A COMPLAINT THAT IS FILED WITH THE COMMISSION? ANYONE WHO BELIEVES HE HAS BEEN DISCRIMINATED AGAINST BECAUSE OF HIS RACE, RELIGION OR NATIONALITY IN HIS SEARCH FOR HOUSING SHOULD FILE A COMPLAINT WITH THE CHICAGO COMMISSION ON HUMAN RELATIONS. THIS IS EASILY DONE BY CONTACTING THE COMMISSION AND ASKING FOR THE DIRECTOR OF HOUSING.

A COMPLAINT SHOULD BE FILED WITH THE CHICAGO Commission on Human Relations.

THE COMMISSION WILL INVESTIGATE ANY COMPLAINT CHARGING UNLAWFUL HOUSING PRACTICES. THE COMMISSION WILL SEEK TO ADJUST SUCH COMPLAINTS, HOLD HEARINGS IF NECESSARY AND MAKE FINDINGS OF FACT. THE MAYOR IS EMPOWERED TO SUSPEND OR REVOKE THE BROKER'S LICENSE OF ANY BROKER FOUND BY THE COMMISSION TO BE VIOLATING THE ORDINANCE. STEPS ALSO CAN BE TAKEN TO REVOKE A BROKER'S STATE LICENSE.
