At the July 1 meeting of the Health Committee, Dr. Karl Olsson, Chairman of the Citizen Committee studying Cook County Hospital, discussed the Citizens Committee report with reference to human relations problems confronting the hospital.

It was decided at that meeting to call a special session of the Health Committee to consider the advisability of sending resolutions to the Commission regarding human relations aspects of the report, and to take up items on the July 1 agenda which were not considered, due to the focus on Dr. Olsson's remarks. These will include a report by Dr. Jasper Williams on the April 11 Conference on Medical Careers sponsored by the National Medical Association at the University of Chicago, and a discussion dealing with the question: Who gives medical care to Chicago's minority groups?
