Dr. Edsel Hudson

I had a conference with Dr. Hudson, well-established internist at Rush Medical College, and former member of the staff at the University of Illinois. At one time, he was the administrative head of Mile Square Medical unit. I have known Dr. Hudson for a number of years, and at one time, was associated with him on the faculty at the University of Illinois.

Our discussions were with reference to whether he might be interested in considering an appointment at CCH. It was understood that this was a preliminary exploration, and that further and more official discussions would ensue if warranted.
