

Group Out to Reopen 2 Dope Clinics Here

A newly formed Citizens Advisory Committee for Rehabilitation of Drug Users will seek city funds to reopen two closed narcotics clinics in Chicago.

A delegation will visit the City Council next Wednesday and seek a conference with Mayor Daley.

Dr. Leoniads Berry of Provident hospital said the closed clinics are at Provident at the Cook County jail.

AT AN organization meeting of the group in the Sherman hotel, Ald. Ralph Metcalfe (3d) promised his support and urged extension of medical treatment to more addicts.

Others who spoke in favor of the clinics are Dr. Benjamin Boshes, head of the department of neurology and psychiatry, Northwestern University; Dr. Irene Sherman, former associate professor of psychiatry, University of Illinois; Dr. Robert Schoop, president of the Cook County Physicians Association; and Capt. Joseph Morris of the narcotics division.

The clinics closed July 1 because of failure of the General Assembly to appropriate funds.
