You may recall that you came to our health careers conference in Chicago at a time when I was president-elect, I believe, of the National Medical Association. As chairman of the Health Commission of the A.M.E. Church, I will be in the midst of conducting programs at the upcoming General Conference, which will be held in Philadelphia, Pa., at the Spectrum at Broad and Patterson Streets. We will have a first-aid clinic there for the group of about 5,000 people who will be in session for two weeks.
