Dear Charles,

You have my letter of yesterday but in addition I must say the following. I am sending you an addendum which should be on a separate page and constitute the last page of the report, one in each of the 500 copies, of course.

May I suggest typewriter-size sheets with a thin or thicker blue back stapled together. This would be fine. Of course, it should be appropriately labeled on the outside. If the following is feasible, alter the order of part of the report so as to have the dates fall chronologically. If it is not feasible, leave it as it is.

I am suggesting that beginning with the last two paragraphs, page 1, and continuing through the last paragraph, page 3, each paragraph could be re-aligned so as to be chronological.

If you do not do the chronological re-arrangement, please scratch out the word chronologically at the beginning of paragraph 3 - page 1, and start the next word with a capital "T." Please also on page 3 - paragraph 1, line 4, type in Apr. 27-29, following the word Mississippi and before 1965. On page 6 - paragraph 2, line 6, scratch out the word an, following the word hold, and just before the word office.

This is all for now, and I hope you can take care of me.
