

Dr. Leonidas Berry Given Writ From University Of Washington

One of the nation's outstanding specialists in stomach diagnosis, Dr. Leonidas H. Berry of Chicago, was guest lecturer at the University of Washington, in Seattle, where he delivered a series of lectures and led discussions centering around the use of the gastroscope as an instrument of diagnosis for stomach ailments.

Dr. Berry's lectures were attended by faculty and students alike. During his stay at the university he was called upon to lecture at King County Hospital Veterans Administration Hospital, and University Hospital — all integral

University of California Medical Center, where he read a paper on his research, entitled: "Diagnostic profile in the detection of Gastric Cancer."

cine, University of Illinois Medical School, member of the Attending Staffs of Cook County Hospital and Provident Hospital, and on the Courtesy Staff of Michael Reese Hospital.
