By now you should have received two letters from the Department of Public Aid notifying of the many changes in Medicaid policy that will be instituted in part by September 1 and the balance January, 1976.


Effective next month, photo copies (Xerox) of Medicaid bills will no longer be accepted. All bills must be typed or legibly printed. You are "strongly encouraged to type all bills in order to speed processing and reduce rejections".

Effective next January, optical character recognition equipment will be used to scan bills which means that all bills must be typed. Also diagnostic information will require optical coding.
