Dear Mr. Weiss:

The copy of the program for the Chicago meeting received. There are two errors in my program listings. One seems to be typographical and the other may be ours. If you plan to have additional copies printed it would be considerably better if the errors can be corrected. The errors are as follows:

On page 27 in the description of my exhibit the title is correct but the authors should be Dr. Leonidas H. Berry, Chicago, Ill., Dr. Jonas Adomavicius, Chicago, Ill., Dr. T. J. Cole, Chicago, Ill., Dr. Robert Schoop, Chicago, Ill., and Juanita Purnell, R.N., Chicago, Ill.

On page 21 the title appears to be a typographical error which amounts to a statement which is unclear. It should read "Recent Experimental and Clinical Experiences with Antacid Therapy in Peptic Ulcer".

Another point is that we requested in our letter to you of May 9th booth space twelve feet long and have been working up our exhibit to fit such a booth, however, I have noticed that in the final description of the space that an eight foot booth has been assigned. If this can be changed to a twelve foot booth it would much better accommodate the exhibit we are building. If this can now be done let me know at once, including whether there would be any change in the color of the booth.
