Dear Dr. Berry:

This is to advise you that your Scientific Exhibit "Serial Observations in Healing of Peptic Ulcers and Physiologic Studies of Anticholinergic Therapy" has been accepted for our 26th Annual Convention at the Sheraton-Cleveland in Cleveland Ohio 23, 24, 25, 26 October 1961.

In a few days you will hear from our exhibit manager Mr. William C. Andrews giving you further details concerning location, shipment, rental of equipment, etc.

May I remind you that the Exhibit Committee has ruled that you, or your representatives, must be present in person during the half-hour preceding the opening of the morning session and the half-hour following the closing of the afternoon session, as well as during the recess periods, morning and afternoon, and during the luncheon hour. The representative must be able to intelligently discuss the subject being presented and to answer any questions which may arise.

MAY WE ALSO REMIND YOU OF THE REGULATION THAT NO MENTION SHOULD BE MADE OF COMMERCIAL FIRMS, AND THAT GENERIC NAMES AND NO TRADE NAMES SHOULD BE USED IN THE EXHIBIT. AN EXCEPTION WILL BE TO PERMIT THE TRADE NAME AND THE FIRM NAME TO APPEAR ONLY IN AN INCONSPICUOUS PLACE AT THE BOTTOM. IN NO INSTANCE CAN THE LETTERS EXCEED 1 INCH IN HEIGHT.
