



NNLM Mission and Goals


Mission - "...health professionals with equal access to biomedical information and improving the public's access to information to enable them to make informed decisions about their health."

NNLM Timeline




NNLM Training






Traveling Exhibitions

- Partnership between NNLM and the History of Medicine Division at NLM
- Exhibitions about people, science & medicine, and history to raise awareness of NLM's resources and collections.
- Light roll-up graphic banners that are easy to install and display.
- 25 unique titles + 3 English/Spanish bilingual exhibitions.

So far, 428 bookings at 282 institutions located in 184 cities in 46 US states and 3 cities in Canada.




Telehealth 101: What libraries need to know



NNLM Other (but not all)

- Foundations of Citizen Science course, a free online training module designed specifically for librarians, downloaded over 11,000 times between 2019 and 2022.
- Partnership with SciStarter produced citizen science activity kits for Spanish speaking and Native American communities.
- "Medical Libraries and Trans Health Education" training addressed health disparities and trans populations.
- The Diverse Voices Toolkit, including bibliographies of titles purchased through the Collection Equity Award in Region 5, was released. The toolkit has been downloaded 1114 unique times (Sept. 2022 Feb. 2023)
- Moby Bookmobile continued outreach to the Wind River Indian Reservation community by distributing culturally relevant health focused books to the Arapaho's Indian Health Service (IHS) clinic.
