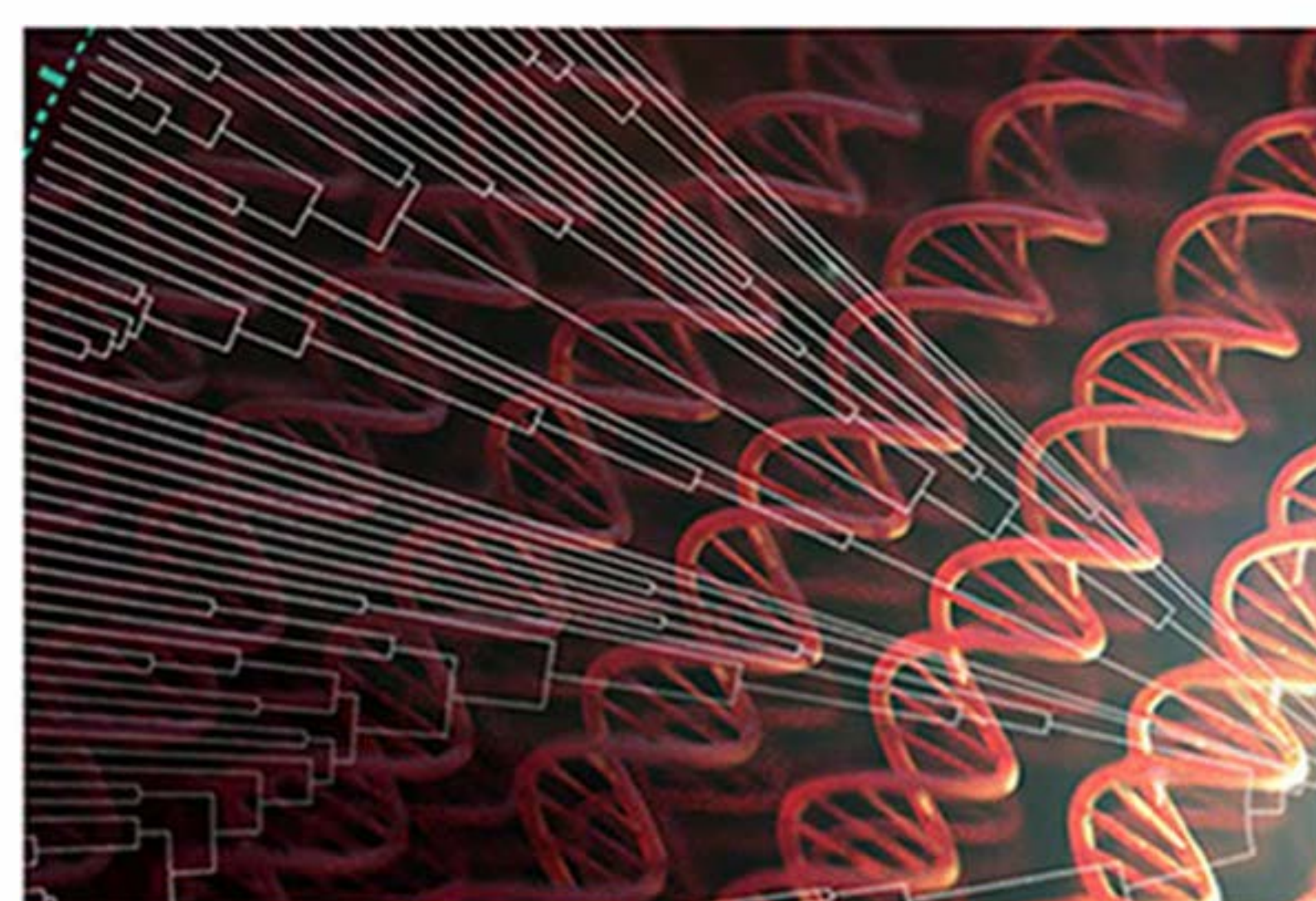


NLM Intramural Research Program

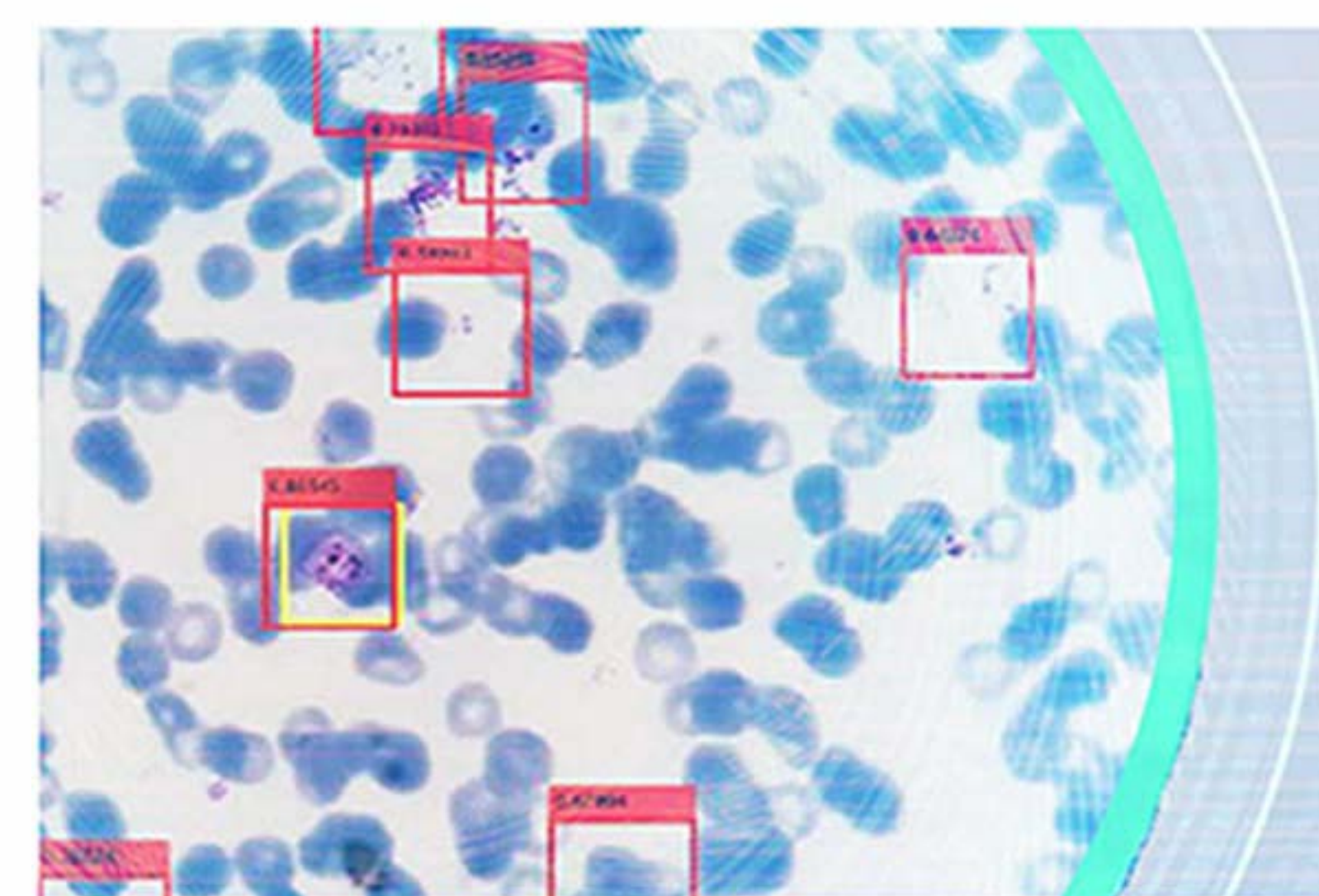
