Purpose:

VSAC stakeholders need tooling that supports more interactive and centralized collaboration among VSAC authors as well as notification of changes.





What does VSAC Collaboration do?

VSAC Collaboration provides a central site for teams to share threaded discussions about value sets, view recent value set expansions posted by members, organize value sets by usage and by team's workflow needs, and receive activity and change notifications from VSAC.





How do memberships and permissions work?

- All members of a value set's author group and steward group are automatically members of each value set's collaboration site.
- The steward can manage the members of the collaboration site and invite additional members if they wish.
- Anyone can request membership to a site, and a steward can approve it.
- The steward can restrict or open membership as they wish, and the steward can create a
 private or open group as they wish.





What is the underlying program for VSAC Collaboration?


We have used the open source Alfresco software.

Alfresco is a customizable Enterprise Content Management (ECM) system that manages content within an enterprise and provides services and controls to manage this content.






Overview of the Upcoming VSAC Collaboration Tool






From VSAC: Create a Collaboration Content Site for a Value Set






From VSAC: Post a Value Set Document to a Collaboration Content Site





Collaboration Workflow Overview




Various Collaboration Workflow Descriptions

- Create a single value set site with default dashboard and members
- Upload value set content
- View value set content within collaboration site
- Invite collaborators to be collaboration content site members
- Add comments, reply to comments
- Add new topics in addition to default topics
- Organize a vote and cast votes to attain consensus on content
- Create a content site based on collections of value sets (in development)
- Create a content site based on steward-defined keywords (in development)








Post a Document from VSAC to your Value Set's Collaboration Site






From within the VSAC Authoring Tool, Access the Collaboration Content Site for a Specific Value Set






Login to VSAC Collaboration to Access the Content Site for a Specific Value Set






View Documents within a Value Set's Collaboration Content Site








View Site Members for a Collaboration Content Site



Each value set content site is automatically populated by all author and stewards for the value set. Every member of the value set's steward group can act as the manager of the value set content site. Site managers can: change Collab roles for each member within the Collab site; remove specific site members from the Collab site; invite external people into the Collab site; approve or reject invitation requests.




Invite Additional Collaborators to Your Value Set Collaboration Site






Search, Invite, Set Roles

VSAC Collaboration will Send Email Notifications to Collab Site Members

- Dropped codes due to code system updates
- Recent activities (member comments, votes, role changes)
- Document upload
- Collab Site Invitation
- Vote on Collab Site Content

In Development:

 Organize Value Sets within one Collab site for easier management and discussions

Examples:

- > All value sets for one measure gathered within a site
- All value sets which a person is contractually managing
- Member Voting Capabilities
- Pull VSAC Content into Collab in addition to the current capability to push VSAC content from VSAC to Collab
